Additional Requirements for Admission to the BFA in Ceramics: Art majors in the B.A. studio program apply to the B.F.A. degree program by taking and passing a 1-credit course (ARTA 3201) during their sophomore year. During the class, students assemble another portfolio of work and written documentation, which they later submit to the BFA Review Committees. Students may not take advanced studio courses without having passed this course and gained acceptance into the B.F.A. program.
