Additional Requirements for Admission to Communication Studies (upper division) Students who apply for the Communication Studies major are initially classified as Pre-Communication Studies majors until they meet the following requirements: cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above; successful completion of a foreign language course at the 2000-level or higher in a Latin alphabet language or American Sign Language or 1202 in a non-Latin alphabet language; and successful (grade C or above) completion of COMM 1101, COMM 2100, and either STAT 1220 or STAT 1222. Students matriculated at UNC Charlotte and planning to change or declare Pre-Communication Studies as their major must have an overall GPA of at least 2.0.

***PLEASE NOTE: UNC Charlotte made changes to the General Education first year writing and Liberal Studies requirements effective Fall 2017; therefore, the UNC Charlotte General Education requirements and community college UGETC course alignment may vary if the associates degree *is not* completed.
