1. An overall GPA of at least 2.7 in a minimum of 45 credit hours in approved college-level courses (or approved program-specific requirements, such as 30 credit hours in approved college-level courses for the Elementary Education, Special Education, and Special Education/Elementary Education dual majors)
2. A grade of C or above in either EDUC 1100 or EDUC 2100, plus SPED 2100 (or approved program-specific requirements such as MDSK 2100 for the Minor in Secondary Education)

Required for Admission from Pre-Child and Family Development to upper division CHFD

3. Passing scores on the Praxis Core: Academic Skills Assessments in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics; or an acceptable substitute score on the SAT or ACT
4. For Elementary, Special Education, and Special Education/Elementary Education dual majors, candidates must take a practice version of the NC General Curriculum Multi-subject Subtest, available free of charge in Canvas
5. Completion and clearance on the Criminal Background Check
6. Signed Statement of Commitment to Professional Dispositions
7. Approval of the Chair (or his or her designee) of the department that offers the program
